I know that I am still too young and they may not take my words seriously. But I have faith in the Lord and believe He has His timetable, His plan and His will. He will add to me His knowledge, lead me to learn more. I don’t care what others think, I am a Christian but I don’t want to show off. I will certainly spread the gospel to my family. Please pray for me.”
